English

Reading; Year Two will follow the phonics scheme and Year Three will be studying 'The Wild Robot' by Peter Brown.

In English we will continue to study 'Jim – A Cautionary Tale' and then move on to 'The Dragon Machine' by Helen Ward.

Maths

Year 2 will work on Place Value to 100 and shape.

Year 3 are continuing their learning about addition and subtraction before starting to learn about multiplication, division and measuring area. Times Tables tests will take place on Thursdays.

PE

Tuesday-Athletics: we will be developing skills such as running at different speeds, jumping and throwing. Friday-Gymnastics: we will be balancing, rolling and jumping.

Music

We will be developing our singing technique. We will learn to improve our vocal control, pitch accuracy, and expression by singing songs inspired by Viking life and culture, while developing our confidence in performing as a group.

Art

In Art we will be developing our knowledge of colour mixing, understanding how texture can be created with paint as well as creating a Christmas collage.

Spanish

We will be continuing with learning numbers 0-10 in Spanish and colours. Then we will be moving onto learning ten animal names, with their determiners.

RE

God – Islam

The key questions we will answer are: 'What do the main concepts in Islam reveal about the nature of Allah?' And 'What is the purpose of visual symbols in a mosque?'

Science

Year 2 will be learning about

History

Our focus this term will be 'How did we learn to fly?' We will learn to identify important events surrounding the history of flight.

Computing

We will be exploring word-processing software by using keyboard shortcuts, importing images and using simple editing tools.

PSHE

In health and wellbeing we will explore the benefits of exercise and relaxation on physical health and wellbeing.
