ENGLISH

This term in English, we will be exploring a range of different stimuli to inspire our writing. Using a variety of texts, images and prompts, pupils will practise writing in different forms, including diary entries, non-chronological reports, descriptive pieces and more. Through these activities, children will continue to develop their vocabulary, sentence structure and ability to write creatively and for different purposes.

MATHS

This term in Maths, we will be focusing on geometry, exploring shape as well as position and direction. Pupils will investigate the properties of different shapes, develop their understanding of angles, and learn how to describe and follow movements using position and direction. This will help to strengthen their spatial reasoning and problem-solving skills.

PE

This term in PE we will be doing Tag Rugby and Rounders.

MUSIC

This term in Music, pupils will explore songs from World War II and learn about the role music played during the war.

DT

This term in DT, pupils will focus on Cooking and Nutrition, designing their own recipe while learning about balanced and healthy meals.

SPANISH

This term in Spanish, pupils will be learning the names of the planets and using simple vocabulary to describe them, while continuing to develop their speaking and pronunciation skills.

RE

This term in RE, pupils will explore inspirational women and consider how their actions and beliefs have influenced others.

SCIENCE

This term in Science, pupils will learn about light and reflection, exploring how light travels and how reflections are formed.

GEOGRAPHY

This term in Geography, pupils will explore where our energy comes from, learning about different energy sources and how they are used in our daily lives.

COMPUTING

This term in Computing, pupils will learn about the history of computers and how technology has developed over time.

PSHE

This term in PSHE, pupils will explore economic wellbeing, learning about money, choices and the importance of managing resources responsibly.
